
Cruce Stark Hall gets \$2.2 mil in renovations to modernize 52-year-old living space



KC reopened Stark Hall on Aug. 16, after eight months of expansive renovations to the residence hall. Tours followed the ribbon-cutting and dedication ceremony. Renovations to the dormitory by Riley Harris Construction include communal restrooms converted into individual, private bathroom pods; replacement of windows, new paint throughout the entire interior of the facility, refurbished hallways, refinished terrazzo floors throughout, refurbished concrete stair steps, additional lighting in the hallways, installation of ceiling fans in all dorm rooms and renovated lobby bathrooms.

Stark Hall was built in 1970 and is the tallest building in Kilgore. It is primarily used to house student-athletes and comfortably houses 178 students. To see more photos from the day, visit our Flickr album here.

Entry fee for the golf tournament at The Tempest Golf Club is \$150 per player or \$600 for a fout-person team (includes green fees for 18 holes, cart usage, KC cap and lunch). Tickets to the brunch are \$25 each. Inductees will also be introduced at halftime of the Hall of Fame football game set for 3 p.m. Saturday, Oct. 21, where the Rangers will face Trinity Valley Community College at R.E. St. John Memorial Stadium in Kilgore.

"We always look forward to the Hall of Fame event because it is one of the most inspirational and motivational events of the year," said Courtney Pruitt, athletic director. "It is such a hard task to narrow down all of the great student-athletes and contributors who have come through our doors over the years to select a few outstanding people each year to honor."
